

## State of Michigan-Executive Orders and Medical Practice

Governor Gretchen Whitmer has issued several Executive Orders (EOs) in response to COVID-19 (2019 novel coronavirus). While several of the EOs impact all Michigan residents generally, four EOs have a direct impact on medical practices. Below is an overview of EOs 2020-07, 2020-17, 2020-21, and 2020-42 to help you understand actions to be taken to ensure your medical practice is in compliance.

### **Executive Order 2020-42 (COVID-19)**

Temporary requirement to suspend activities that are not necessary to sustain or protect life.  
Rescission of Executive Order 2020-21.
